REPRESENTING, NEGOTIATING & INFLUENCING

As you know, your Federation is here to advise and assist you throughout the year with any Conduct, Criminal, Health Management or other issues that may affect your day to day work as a police officer, whether on or off duty.

Should you require any assistance, then please make us your first point of contact so we can effectively negotiate and represent you from the outset.

INJURY ON DUTY REPORTING

In order for us to continue to provide the *best possible* service to officers who are injured/assaulted on duty, it is imperative that supervisors complete an Accident Report via the Force system *at their earliest possible convenience*. This then allows us to contact the respective officers promptly, highlighting the various support options available to them.

Depending on the nature of their injury and which schemes an officer is subscribing to, options can include submitting a **Group Accident claim**, completing a **Civil or Criminal Injuries Compensation claim**, making an application to attend **The Police Treatment Centres**, reclaiming associated Prescription costs/medical expenses from the Force etc.

The prompt submission of Accident Reports also alerts us to any welfare issues which could potentially arise as a result of an incident/injury, so we can offer ongoing advice and support in relation to any health management issues.

CARRYING TASER IN COURT

After many years of challenging, lobbying and providing evidence from our members, the Lord Chief Justice has agreed to allow officers to carry Taser in Court as part of their operational equipment when attending Court on routine business, such as giving evidence or delivering exhibits.
